

Dress Code For Titleholder

- 1 - Ball caps may be worn as long as they are worn forward at all times.**
- 2 - Any headgear "without" a bill cannot be worn (bandanas, dew rages, headbands, beanie, etc).**
- 3 - tank tops, undershirt tank-tops, plain white under t-shirt, and cut-off sleeves cannot be worn.**
- 4 - No jerseys may be worn NFL, MLB, NHL, and NBA etc.**
- 5 - ABSOLUTELY NO CUT OR TORN CLOTHING.**
- 6 - No offensive or obscene shirts.**

Any and all persons violating these rules will be asked to change their clothing. If they refuse they will be asked to leave tournament area and not return. Any and all questions, please see the tournament committee.

Reason for dress code is to insure no one in the tournament, or the establishment in which the tournament is played, is offended. Also, it is meant to keep the professionalism in the sport. Remember you are playing in a national qualifying tournament, and are representing the state/bar/pool hall/league operator, and your team.
